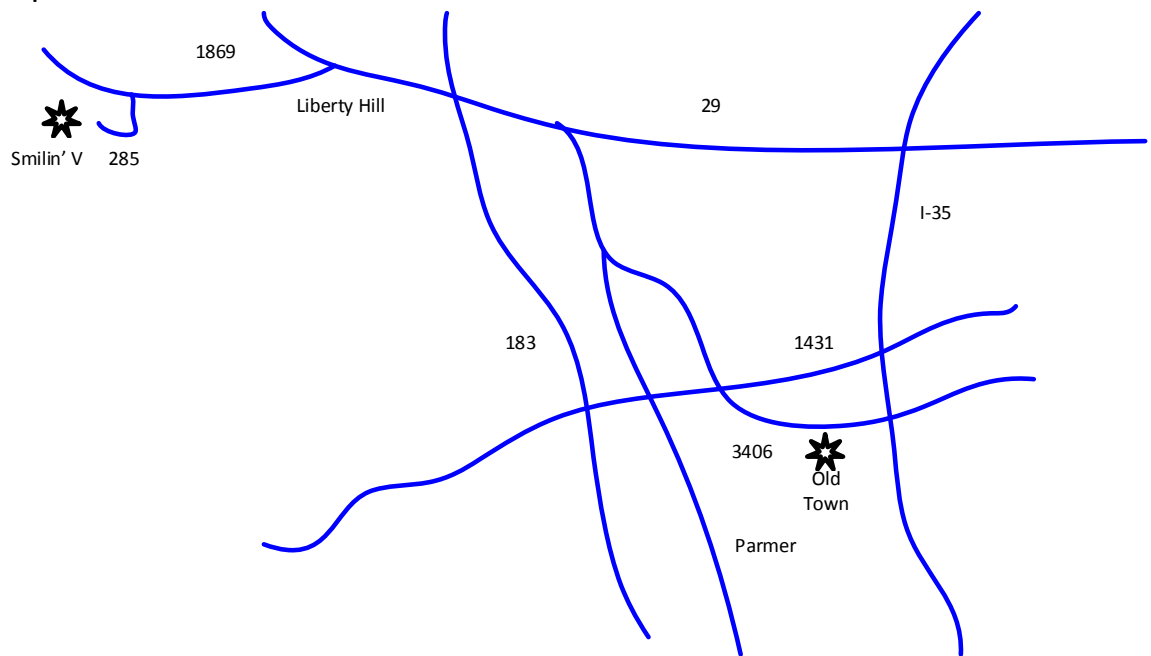


Pack 165 - fall 2017 Campout

- After leaving Liberty Hill on FM/CR 1869 **DO NOT TAKE THE FIRST CR 285** (apx 4 miles from Hwy 29)
- Continue on to the **second exit** (apx 6 miles from Hwy 29) **for CR 285**, about 2 miles further down FM/CR 1869 (it will provide you a shorter distance and safer road way)

Required Forms: Please print and sign the medical forms and YPT certificate and bring them to the October or November pack meeting. Submit the vehicle information form online.

***All campers** (youth and adults) must submit BSA medical forms A and B.

Camping Checklist

Bring the following items with you.

PERSONAL GEAR

- Scout Book
- Closed-toed shoes
- Scout uniform (wear it on arrival)
- Class-B uniform (Pack165 or any scouting T-shirt)
- Pants, shirt, underwear, 2 pair socks for each day
- Jacket
- Pajamas or short pants for sleeping
- Hat
- Stocking cap for warmth at night
- Rain Gear (coat and pants)
- Sleeping Bag
- Sleeping Pad
- Pillow
- Flashlight (extra batteries)
- Refillable Water Bottle
- Bug Spray
- Washcloth, small towel
- Toothbrush and paste
- Tent

OPTIONAL

- Fishing Pole / Tackle Box
- Laundry Bag
- Walking Stick
- Backpack
- Sunscreen
- First Aid Kit
- Watch
- Lantern (Extra Batteries)
- Cot
- Chair
- Cart for hauling gear
- Fishing Pole (there is a pond in the camp)
- Table
- Pop-up Canopy
- Cooler
- Toilet Paper

****Items NOT to bring****

BB guns, bow and arrow, personal firearms, fireworks, electronic games, alcohol
